## What is Lutherhaven like?

Majestic trees, inspirational views, and gracious hospitality all describe Camp Lutherhaven, situated on scenic Lake Coeur d'Alene eight miles south of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. Coffee, tea, and water are always available. The beautiful chapel has large windows overlooking the lake, comfortable chairs, and a towering rock fireplace for a memorable cozy atmosphere. A delicious breakfast and lunch will be served. The clean rooms are shared between two to six women, with comfortable beds and private bathrooms for each room.

- Casual clothes and shoes for walking
- Afghan or snuggly blanket (to keep cozy late at night)
- Snack to share for Friday night (eat dinner before you come or bring something)
